- Bylaws and Dues

  - O The question of how to run the SHOA without clear knowledge weighs on the current Board, however, the Board voted to keep the dues at \$100, because the previous Board raised them and the current 2019 budget (see attached budget) supports the need for more than \$50. Vote 4 yes, 2 no to keep dues at \$100. The 2 Board members voted no because the dues do not match the Bylaws.
- Is a neighborhood meeting, possibly in January, needed in addition to the mandatory May meeting to get feedback from neighbors and to provide a means of more communication? Board members voted: 4 No, 2 Yes

- Gave detailed review of budget and 2019 spending projections (attached).
- Budget does not include \$400 payment to Mulberry Gardens which had been discussed because Mulberry has not billed the SHOA, and SHOA may never get billed.
- The Board discussed having the devil strip trees cut down because many are diseased.
  - Chuck counted 38 trees that needed removed because of disease or alignment, however having all the trees removed was also proposed to keep the uniform look of the allotment.
