Dear Neighbor,

For many years we have placed luminaries along our curbs on Christmas Eve. The display is spectacular, and there is no cost to you for the candles, which burn for 6 to 8 hours.

We ask you to begin collecting clear gallon water/milk jugs. Look for a large box to be placed near the SHOA memo board; we encourage everyone with extra jugs to place them inside the box for others who cannot save enough jugs. Each single lot will display 8 luminaries, corner lots will display 15, and lots on a cul-de-sac will display 5. Enclosed are the "official" luminary candles. Shown below are pictures showing how the milk jugs are set up with cutting the jugs, anchoring the bottom with kitty litter, and placing the candle.

Light the candles at 6 p.m. on Christmas Eve. If you have to light them earlier, it's fine because they burn for hours. The jugs should be evenly spaced on top of the curb (or snow). If you won't be available to light your own candles, please collect and set them up and ask a neighbor to light them for you. It is such a beautiful display when we have 100% participation!
