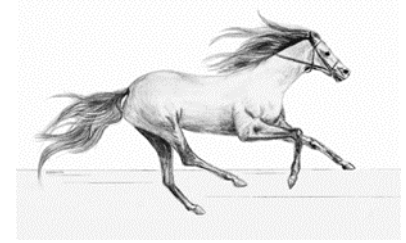


Steeplechase Home Owners Association Winter Newsletter

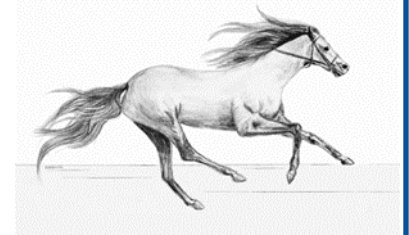
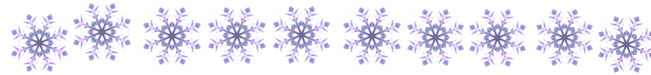

The Sibits moved from the Stow area, wanting to stay in the school district for the kids.

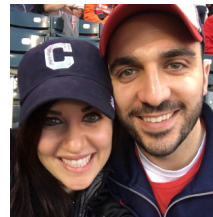
Jen is the Dean of Students (aka assistant principal) at an elementary school in Akron and Shawn works for the Social Security Department.

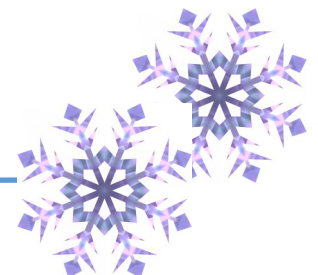

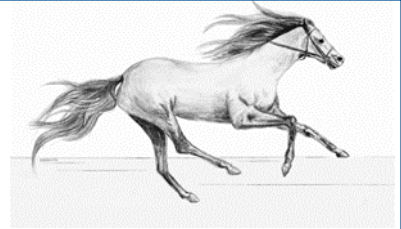

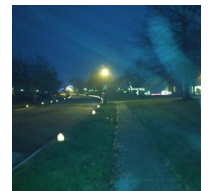
SHOA Sponsored Neighborhood Events

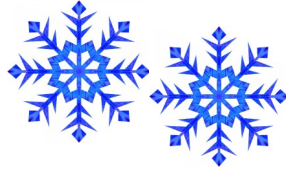
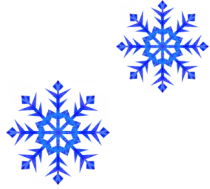
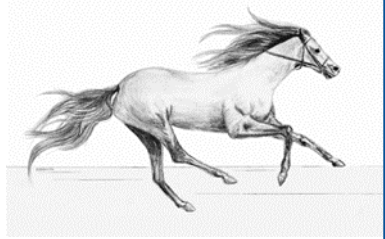


2020-2021 SHOA Board Committee

City Reminders

As always, the Steeplechase Homeowner's Association is committed to maintaining the best possible relationship with the city of Munroe Falls and its city services personnel. As citizens of the Munroe Falls community, Steeplechase residents can help by observing the following as we move into the winter season:

- ⇒ Please ensure household residents and guests do not park on Steeplechase neighborhood streets when there is snow accumulation. This helps our city services to effectively maintain safely plowed roads during snow storms.
- ⇒ Do you have any clothing, shoes, linens, textiles or small appliances (those that can be moved by one person) to discard? Rather than throwing them away, please consider the city's Simple Recycling program. Items can be placed in the program's orange bags and picked up for free on trash days. More information is available at <https://www.munroefalls.com/164/Simple-Recycling>
- ⇒ Speaking of trash pickup, please make sure your recycling and trash cans are arranged with the front of the cans facing the street. This allows easy access for the automatic retrieval arm used by Kimball trucks.
- ⇒ If you have an event to plan (family reunion, party, reception, organizational meeting, etc.) consider booking one of the city's fine community facilities. The Lehner Community Center is available for rental at reasonable rates, and it holds up to 49 people. Larger groups (up to 78) can be hosted at the Guise Park Lodge.
